THIS IS A COMPETITIVE CIVIL SERVICE POSITION.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The incumbent in this class performs professional activities which may include the investigation and inspection of the non-engineering aspects of environmental health control. The Public Health Sanitarian applies the principles of the physical, biological and social sciences for the detection, evaluation, control and management of those factors in the environment which influence health. The incumbent performs under the supervision of a higher level Public Health Sanitarian. Supervision is exercised over subordinate technical personnel. The incumbent performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application. Either:

- (A) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered four-year college or university with a Bachelor's Degree, including thirty (30) credit hours in the natural sciences* of which not more than twelve (12) credit hours may be in the applied sciences**; **OR**
- (B) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma **AND** five (5) years of experience as a public health technician deemed satisfactory by the local commissioner of health or public health director and have satisfactorily completed a public health training course approved by the State Health Department.

*The term natural science shall mean a science such as biology, chemistry or physics that deals with the objects, phenomena, or laws of nature and the physical world. It shall include all physical and biological sciences.

**The term applied science shall mean science based courses in environmental technology, sanitation technology, medical technology, public health, infection control or food science.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at time of appointment. License must remain valid throughout appointment.

NOTE: Appointees under (A) above must satisfactorily complete a public health training course approved by the State Health Department within two years of appointment.
