**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** This position exists in the Engineering Division of the Oneida County Department of Public Works. The incumbent has responsibility for performing the highest professional level of proficiency in the field of civil engineering. Major problems and policy decisions are discussed with the Commissioner of Public Works. Does related work as required.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidates must meet the minimum qualification at time of application. Either:

- (A) Possession of a Master's Degree in civil or environmental engineering from a regionally accredited or New York State registered school of engineering AND six (6) years of experience involving civil or environmental engineering; OR
- (B) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Bachelor's Degree in civil or environmental engineering AND seven (7) years of experience as described in (A) above; OR
- (C) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Bachelor's Degree in engineering AND nine (9) years of experience as described in (A) above; OR
- (D) An equivalent combination of training and experience, as defined by the limits of (A) through (C) above.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:** Possession of a current valid Professional Engineer's License issued by the New York State Education Department at time of appointment.

**NOTE:** Candidates **MUST** submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred.
