<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: This position involves a variety of building maintenance and repair tasks of a skilled or semiskilled nature. Employees in this class are required to work in various mechanical trades as the occasion demands. In this respect, the class differs from such classes as Painter, Carpenter, Plumber, etc., which limit incumbents to a single trade. The duties of this class differ from Building Maintenance Worker due to the more skilled nature of the work involved. Incumbents perform their duties with some latitude for independent planning or laying out of the work details. The incumbent performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application. Either:

- (A) Graduation for a regionally accredited of New York State registered college or university with an Associate's Degree in construction, engineering technology, or a closely related field AND one (1) year of experience in building construction or one of the standard trades; **OR**
- (B) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma **AND** three (3) years of experience in building construction or one of the standard trades; **OR**
- (C) Four (4) years of experience in building construction or one of the standard trades.
