THIS IS A COMPETITIVE CIVIL SERVICE POSITION.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is professional and administrative work involving responsibility for planning, organizing and supervising the activities of the department of Planning. The work includes promoting, encouraging and coordinating business, industrial, recreational, commercial and economic development of the Commissioner of Planning. Supervision is exercised over the work of technical, professional and clerical assistants for assignments and review of work. The incumbent performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application.
Either:

- (A) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Master's Degree or higher in city, regional or urban planning from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university **AND** four (4) years of **professional planning experience***, two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity;
- (B) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Master's Degree or higher in planning, architecture, landscape architecture, environmental science, engineering, sociology, public administration, geography, natural resources, criminal justice, statistics or a closely related field **AND** five (5) years of **professional planning experience***, two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity; **OR**
- (C) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Bachelor's Degree or higher in city, regional or urban planning **AND** five (5) years of **professional planning experience***, two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity; **OR**
- (D) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Bachelor's Degree or higher in planning, architecture, landscape architecture, environmental science, engineering, sociology, public administration, geography, natural resources, criminal justice, statistics or a closely related field **AND** six (6) years of **professional planning experience***, two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

***Professional planning experience** - Teaching the subjects of land use planning, urban planning, economic development, environmental design, planning workshops, planning studios, community planning studios, transportation planning, sociology, civil engineering, human services, and similar courses in a collegiate setting is also considered qualifying experience.

NOTES:

- 1. Candidates **MUST** submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred.
- 2. Verifiable part-time experience will be pro-rated toward meeting full-time experience requirements.
