THIS IS A COMPETITIVE CIVIL SERVICE POSITION.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This position involves performance of tasks involving the development, implementation, and enforcement of a safety program covering employees. The work is performed in accordance with established policies and procedures including OSHA/PESH regulations. Duties are performed under the general supervision of a higher-level superior, with leeway allowed in designing and carrying out the details of the safety program. Supervision over the work of others is not a responsibility of this class. The incumbent performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application. Either:

- (A) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Bachelor's Degree **AND** two (2) years of experience involving responsibility for the administration, training, coordination, or enforcement of job safety or environmental health and safety regulations; **OR**
- (B) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with an Associate's Degree **AND** four (4) years of experience involving responsibility for the administration, training, coordination, or enforcement of job safety or environmental health and safety regulations.

NOTE: Candidates **MUST** submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at time of appointment. License must remain valid throughout appointment.
