THIS IS A NON-COMPETITIVE CIVIL SERVICE POSITION.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This position involves responsibility to provide routine sub-professional nursing care of patients in accordance with detailed and well-defined policies, rules and regulations. In the Skilled Nursing Facility, employees assist a Registered Professional Nurse in the care of patients. In a School District or Department, employees assist either a School Nurse Teacher, Registered Professional Nurse (school), School Physician or other Supervisor, in providing health care. The work requires the understanding of, and skill in, routine nursing practices, but does not require the exercise of professional judgement called for in the position of Registered Professional Nurse. Supervision may be exercised over Nursing Assistants. The work is performed under the supervision of either a Registered Professional Nurse, Licensed Physician, or other Supervisor. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application. *Possession of a New York State temporary permit to practice **OR** current valid New York State license as a Licensed Practical Nurse.

*A temporary appointment may be made up to the duration of the temporary permit **or** receipt of the Licensed Practical Nurse license.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of an appropriate level, valid New York State Driver's License at time of appointment.

NOTE: Candidates **MUST** submit with application a copy of New York State temporary permit to practice **OR** current valid New York State license as a Licensed Practical Nurse.
