## **THIS IS A COMPETITIVE CIVIL SERVICE POSITION.**

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** The term "public health engineer" shall mean a person who applies engineering principles for the detection, evaluation, control, and management of those factors in the environment which may influence public health. This position exists in the County Public Health Department and involves responsibility for the planning and performance of public health engineering duties concerned with the execution of one or more phases of the environmental health program. The work entails advising public officials or individuals on problems requiring public health engineering expertise, including measures for improvement and compliance with legal requirements, assisting in the promotion of public health through application of environmental health practices, assisting in the enforcement of the provisions of local and State health matters and investigations of related conditions and problems. The work is performed under general supervision. Supervision is exercised over the work of subordinate employees. Does related work as required.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application. Either:

Possession of Bachelor's Degree in engineering **OR** a license to practice as a Professional Engineer in New York State.

### **NOTES:**

1. Candidates **MUST** submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred or copy of Professional Engineer license.
2. Degree(s) must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If the degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the candidate must provide independent verification of equivalency.
