THIS IS A COMPETITIVE CIVIL SERVICE POSITION.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This position involves responsibility for performing physical, chemical, bacteriological and microscopic examination and analysis of raw and treated wastewater, sludge and industrial waste. The incumbent is responsible for performing standard laboratory tests and procedures required for control of the treatment process and necessary stream or industrial waste surveys. The work is performed under supervision of the Water Resources Chemist, with leeway allowed for the exercise of independent judgement in carrying out details of the work. May supervise subordinate laboratory personnel. The incumbent performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application.

Open Competitive: Either:

- (A) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Bachelor's Degree in chemistry, biology, laboratory technology, engineering, civil, chemical, physical or biological sciences or a closely related field; **OR**
- (B) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with an Associate's Degree in chemistry, biology, laboratory technology, engineering, civil, chemical, physical or biological sciences or a closely related field, **AND** two (2) years of experience in performing technical laboratory tests involving water or wastewater analysis

Promotional:

Full-time, permanent competitive status for a period of twenty-four (24) months as a Laboratory Technician (Wastewater Treatment) in the Oneida County Department of Water Quality & Water Pollution Control.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at time of appointment. License must remain valid throughout appointment.
