DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This position involves responsibility for performing physical, chemical, bacteriological, and microscopic examination, and analysis of raw and treated wastewater, sludge, and industrial waste. The incumbent is responsible for performing standard laboratory tests and procedures required for control of the treatment process and necessary stream or industrial waste surveys. The work is performed under supervision of the Water Resources Chemist, with leeway allowed for the exercise of independent judgement in carrying out details of the work. May supervise subordinate laboratory personnel. The incumbent performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application. Either:

- (A) Possession of Bachelor's Degree in chemistry, biology, laboratory technology, engineering, civil, chemical, physical or biological sciences or a closely related field; **OR**
- (B) Possession of Associate's Degree in chemistry, biology, laboratory technology, engineering, civil, chemical, physical or biological sciences or a closely related field, **AND** two (2) years of experience in performing technical laboratory tests involving water or wastewater analysis.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at time of appointment. License must remain valid throughout appointment.

NOTES:

1. Candidates **MUST** submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred.
2. Degree(s) must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If the degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the candidate must provide independent verification of equivalency. 3. Verifiable part-time experience will be pro-rated toward meeting full-time experience requirements.
