

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application.

Candidates must have satisfactorily completed a New York State Department of Health Basic Environmental Health Program (BEHP) **AND** Either:

Health Sanitarian. Supervision is exercised over the work of Public Health Sanitarians and Public Health

- (A) Possession of Bachelor's Degree, including thirty (30) credit hours in the natural sciences\* of which not more than twelve (12) credit hours may be in the applied sciences\*\* **AND** two (2) years of experience as a Public Health Sanitarian or equivalent environmental health experience; **OR**
- (B) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma **AND** five (5) years of experience as a public health technician deemed satisfactory by the local commissioner of health or public health director, **AND** two (2) years of experience as a Public Health Sanitarian or equivalent environmental health experience.

\*The term natural science shall mean a science such as biology, chemistry or physics that deals with the objects, phenomena, or laws of nature and the physical world. It shall include all physical and biological sciences.

\*\*The term applied science shall mean science-based courses in environmental technology, sanitation technology, medical technology, public health, infection control or food science.

## **NOTES:**

- 1. Candidates **MUST** submit with application a copy of transcripts, if qualifying under (A).
- Degree(s) must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If the degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the candidate must provide independent verification of equivalency.
