

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application. Either:

- (A) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma AND at least thirty (30) credit hours from a regionally accredited or New York State college, twelve (12) credits of which were in automotive technology courses; OR
- (B) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma, including or supplemented by a two-year NYS Certified BOCES Program in Automotive Technology; **OR**
- (C) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma **AND** two (2) years of experience as a skilled automotive mechanic.

## **SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at time of appointment. License must remain valid throughout appointment.
- 2. Must obtain a valid NYS Motor Vehicle Inspection License within six (6) months of appointment. License must remain valid throughout appointment.
- 3. Certain assignments made to employees in this class will require access to transportation to meet field work requirements in a timely and efficient manner.

## **NOTES:**

- 1. Candidates **MUST** submit with application of transcripts, if qualifying under (A)
- 2. Candidates **MUST** submit with application of the two-year NYS Certified BOCES Program in Automotive Technology, if qualifying under (B).
- 3. Degree(s) must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If the degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the candidate must provide independent verification of equivalency. Candidates will be required to pay the evaluation fee.
