

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application.

Possession of Bachelor's degree or higher with at least thirty (30) credit hours in the social or behavioral sciences.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:** Where required, possession of a current driver's license or the ability to otherwise meet the transportation requirements of the position.

## NOTES:

- Candidates MUST submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred.
- 2. Degree(s) must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If the degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the candidate must provide independent verification of equivalency. Candidates will be required to pay the evaluation fee.
- 3. Social science includes areas of study concerned with humans living in relation to other humans in a social environment and such as anthropology, criminal justice, economics, geography, history, political science, psychology, and sociology.
- 4. Behavioral science is a subset of social science characterized by observation of the behavior of living organisms and focused on human social behavior such as psychology, sociology, anthropology, counseling, criminal justice, gerontology, human behavior, social work/social welfare, and vocational rehabilitation.
- 5. Individuals whose duties and responsibilities include the use of a firearm must also complete training pursuant to Criminal Procedure Law Section 2.30(3).
- 6. The class specifications including the minimum qualifications for positions in Probation Departments are established by rule and regulations of the Division of Criminal Justice Services. These class specifications are found in Title 9 NYCRR Part 347, Appendix H-10, Standard Specifications for Professional Probation Positions.
- 7. This position is allocated to the competitive class pursuant to Executive Law Section 257(1).
