

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application. Either:

- (A) Possession of Associate's degree in engineering technology, Construction Technology, or a closely related field **AND** four (4) year of experience in the maintenance or construction of roads and sewers or related public works activities, one (1) year of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity; **OR**
- (B) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma **AND** six (6) years of experience in the maintenance or construction of roads and sewers or related public works activities, one (1) year of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity; **OR**
- (C) Eight (8) years of experience in the maintenance or construction of roads and sewers or related public works activities, one (1) year of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Possession of a valid Commercial Driver's License Class B or higher without air brake restriction at time of application and for duration of appointment.
- 2. Possession of an OPP (one person plowing) Certification within one year of appointment and for duration of appointment.
- 3. Certain assignments made to employees in this class will require access to transportation to meet field work requirements in a timely and efficient manner.

NOTES:

- 1. Candidates **MUST** submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred, if qualifying under (A).
- 2. Degree(s) must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If the degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the candidate must provide independent verification of equivalency. A list of acceptable companies who provide this service can be found at http://www.cs.ny.gov/jobseeker/degrees.cfm. Candidates will be required to pay the evaluation fee.
- 3. Verifiable part-time experience as described above will be pro-rated toward meeting full-time requirements.
