

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application. Either:

- (A) Possession of a Master's Degree from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university in civil engineering, mechanical engineering, environmental engineering, or a closely related field and three (3) years of experience in the design, construction, project management or operation of engineering projects, with at least one (1) of those years being in a supervisory capacity; **OR**
- (B) Possession of Bachelor's degree in civil engineering, mechanical engineering, environmental engineering, or a closely related field and four (4) years of experience in the design, construction, management or operation of engineering projects, with at least one (1) of those years being in a supervisory capacity; **OR**
- (C) Possession of Associate's degree in civil engineering, mechanical engineering, environmental engineering, or a closely related field and six (6) years of experience in design, construction, management or operation of engineering projects, with at least one (1) of those years being in a supervisory capacity.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:** Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at time of appointment. License must remain valid throughout appointment.

## NOTES:

- Candidates MUST submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred.
- 2. Degree(s) must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If the degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the candidate must provide independent verification of equivalency.
