

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application.

Possession of a current valid license, issued by the New York State Education Department, to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse **AND** Either:

- (A) Possession of Bachelor's Degree in nursing AND one (1) year of professional nursing experience; OR
- (B) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered three (3) year school of professional nursing **AND** two (2) years of professional nursing experience; **OR**
- (C) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered two (2) year school of professional nursing **AND** three (3) years of professional nursing experience.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:** Certain assignments made to employees in this class will require access to transportation to meet field work requirements in a timely and efficient manner.

## NOTES:

- Candidates MUST submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred.
- Candidates MUST submit with application a copy of current Registered Professional Nurse License.
- 3. Degree(s) must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If the degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the candidate must provide independent verification of equivalency.
