DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Responsible for more complex subprofessional assignments including supervising engineering support services, field work, and other related technical duties pertaining to the Oneida County Sewer District wastewater treatment and conveyance systems. Assignments are received orally or in writing and are general in nature. Supervision may be exercised over subordinate staff or staff temporarily assigned to assist with engineering support services. Work is generally performed under the direction of the Senior Engineer or designee. The incumbent performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application.

Possession of Associate's Degree in environmental science, engineering or architectural technology, or surveying technology, or closely related field **AND** five (5) years progressive experience as an engineering technician with emphasis on public works, utility, and/or water/wastewater.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at time of appointment. License must remain valid throughout appointment.

NOTES:

1. Candidates **MUST** submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred.
2. Degree(s) must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If the degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the candidate must provide independent verification of equivalency.
