

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application. Either:

- (A) Possession of Bachelor's Degree in mechanical engineering, environmental engineering, mechanical technology, electrical technology or electrical engineering **AND** three (3) years of experience in a combination of maintenance and repair of heating, ventilating, and air conditioning systems, electrical and instrumentation systems, and equipment and machinery of the type used in a wastewater treatment plant\*, two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity; **OR**
- (B) Possession of Associate's Degree in mechanical engineering, environmental engineering, mechanical technology, electrical technology or electrical engineering **AND** five (5) years of experience in a combination of maintenance and repair of heating, ventilating, and air conditioning systems, electrical and instrumentation systems, and equipment and machinery of the type used in a wastewater treatment plant\*, two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity; **OR**
- (C) Graduation from a high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma **AND** seven (7) years of experience in a combination of maintenance and repair of heating, ventilating, and air conditioning systems, electrical and instrumentation systems, and equipment and machinery of the type used in a wastewater treatment plant\*, two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

\*Includes mechanical screens machines, force mains, grit removal equipment, presses, pumps, valves, and all other equipment used in wastewater treatment and pumping systems.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:** Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at time of application. License must remain valid throughout appointment.

## NOTES:

- 1. Candidates **MUST** submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred, if qualifying under (A) or (B).
- 2. Degree(s) must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If the degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the candidate must provide independent verification of equivalency. - 3. Verifiable part-time experience as described above will be pro-rated toward meeting full-time requirements.
