**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** This position involves responsibility to supervise and perform repair and maintenance of heavy automotive equipment used in construction and maintenance of highways and/or snow removal and ice control. This class differs from that of Heavy Equipment Mechanic by virtue of added supervisory duties, equipment inspection, performance of the more difficult repairs, and overall responsibility for efficient and effective maintenance and repair of the heavy equipment fleet. Additionally, an incumbent is required to be able to operate the various types of heavy equipment for road testing and not operational purposes. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Commissioner of Aviation, with leeway allowed for the exercise of independent judgment in carrying out technical details of the work. Supervision is exercised over the work of Heavy Equipment and Auto Mechanics. The incumbent performs related work as required.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application.

Four (4) years of experience as a skilled automotive mechanic, which shall have involved repair and maintenance of heavy automotive equipment.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Possession of a valid appropriate level Motor Vehicle Operator's license issued by the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles at time of appointment. This license must be maintained throughout appointment.
2. Certain assignments made to employees in this class will require access to transportation to meet field work requirements in a timely and efficient manner.

**NOTE:** Verifiable part-time experience will be pro-rated toward meeting full-time experience requirements.
