

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application. Either:

- (A) Possession of Bachelor's Degree in police justice, criminology or a closely related field **AND** two (2) years of experience in investigative work or law enforcement**; **OR**
- (B) Possession of Associate's Degree in criminal justice or a closely related field **AND** four (4) years of experience in investigative work or law enforcement**; **OR**
- (C) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma **AND** six (6) years of experience in investigative work or law enforcement**.

**Law Enforcement is defined as "the enforcement of Federal, State or local laws governing society with the right to make arrests."

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Possession of a valid New York State Driver's License at time of appointment. This license must be maintained throughout appointment.
- 2. Candidates <u>must have</u> ten (10) more years of additional experience beyond the number of years of experience stated in (A), (B), and (C) above; **AND**
 - a. Must have issued no less than one thousand (1000) uniformed traffic tickets; **OR**
 - b. Must have been the lead investigator on no less than twenty (20) "B" Felony level (NYS PENAL LAW, or equivalent State or Federal Law) investigations; **OR**
 - c. Must have been the lead investigator on no less than twenty (20) economic crime investigations; OR
 - d. Must have been the lead investigator on no less than two (2) homicide investigations.

NOTES:

- Candidates MUST submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred, if qualifying under (A) or (B).
- Degree(s) must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If the degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the candidate must provide independent verification of equivalency. A list of acceptable companies who provide this service can be found on the Internet at http://www.cs.ny.gov/jobseeker/degrees.cfm. Candidates will be required to pay the evaluation fee.
- 3. Verifiable part-time experience will be pro-rated toward meeting full-time experience requirements.
