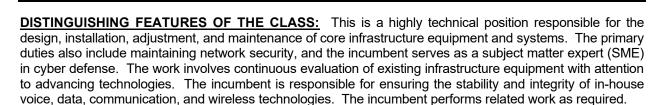

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application. Either:

- (A) Possession of Bachelor's Degree in Cyber Security, Computer Information Systems, Telecommunications, Network Engineering or closely related field **AND** two (2) years of experience in local area network (LAN)/wide area network (WAN) implementation and maintenance; **OR**
- (B) Possession of Associate's Degree in Cyber Security, Computer Information Systems, Telecommunications or Network Engineering or closely related field **AND** four (4) years of experience in local area network (LAN)/wide area network (WAN) implementation and maintenance.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at time of appointment. License must remain valid throughout appointment.
- 2. Criminal Justice Information Systems (CJIS) Security Clearance is required for appointment and must be maintained throughout appointment.

NOTES:

- Candidates MUST submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred.
- Degree(s) must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If the degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the candidate must provide independent verification of equivalency.
