

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application. Either:

- Possession of Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice, criminology or a closely related field AND six (6) years of (A) experience as a sworn law enforcement officer of which two (2) years must have been in an administrative or supervisory capacity; OR
- (B) Possession of Associate's Degree in criminal justice or a closely related field AND eight (8) years of experience of experience as a sworn law enforcement officer of which two (2) years must have been in an administrative or supervisory capacity; OR
- (C) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma AND ten (10) years of experience of experience as a sworn law enforcement officer of which two (2) years must have been in an administrative or supervisory capacity.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Candidates must have ten (10) more years of additional experience beyond the number of years of experience stated in (A), (B), and (C) above; **AND**
 - Must have been the lead investigator on no less than twenty-five (25) "B" Felony level (NYS PENAL LAW, or a. equivalent State or Federal Law) investigations; OR
 - b. Must have been the lead investigator on no less than twenty-five (25) economic crime investigations; OR
 - Must have been the lead investigator on no less than three (3) homicide investigations.
- 2. Candidate must have current certification from NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) showing validation of Police Officer Registry Status or qualify for the certification under General Municipal Law § 209-q(b).
- Candidate must have a firearms certification at the time of application.
- Possession of a valid New York State Driver's License at time of appointment. This license must be maintained throughout appointment.

NOTES:

- Candidates MUST submit with application a copy of transcripts showing degree area and date degree conferred, if qualifying under (A) or (B).
- 2. Degree(s) must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If the degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the candidate must provide independent verification of equivalency. A list of acceptable companies who provide this service can be found at http://www.cs.ny.gov/jobseeker/degrees.cfm. Candidates will be required to pay the evaluation fee. Verifiable part-time experience will be pro-rated toward meeting full-time experience requirements.
