<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:</u> This is manual work involving the performance of a variety of preventative maintenance and repair activities pertaining to a municipal sanitary sewage collection system and sewage treatment plant. May be required to assist with making minor repairs to equipment and ordinary servicing. Requires skill in the operation of light-duty equipment. The work is performed under the direct supervision of a higher-level supervisor, with leeway allowed for the exercise of independent judgment in carrying out the technical details of the job. Supervision over the work of others is not a responsibility of employees in this class. The incumbent works under the general supervision of the Sewer Maintenance and Equipment Supervisor or designee. The incumbent performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications at time of application.

Graduation from a high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma **AND** one (1) year of experience in the performance of heavy manual labor and utilization of tools and operation of mechanical and automotive equipment in the performance of that work.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at time of appointment. License must remain valid throughout appointment.

NOTE: Verifiable part-time experience will be pro-rated toward meeting full-time experience requirements.
